INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR AGREEMENT

THIS INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR AGREEMENT is between RSA Consulting Group, LLC ("Contractor") and the Water Street Tampa Improvement District and is executed January 1, 2021.

WHEREAS, Contractor is qualified to provide liaison and advisory services regarding Company's governmental relations; and

WHEREAS, both parties are in accord that the terms and conditions of the independent contractor relationship ought to be set forth in writing, and this document, hereinafter referred to as this "Agreement," is prepared for that purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises in this Agreement and of the engagement of Contractor by Company as governmental relations consultant, the receipt and adequacy of all of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. <u>Contractor's Work for Company</u>. As directed by Company's chief executive officer and its other executive officers, Contractor shall provide liaison and advisory services to Company in connection with its relationship with all relevant government agencies, departments, and elected officials.
- **2.** <u>Scope of Services.</u> Advise and develop strategy for a local bill to amend the boundaries of the Water Street Tampa Improvement District.
 - **3. Fees.** Contractor will provide services pro-bono.
- **4.** <u>Term of Agreement</u>. The initial term of this Agreement shall commence on January 1, 2021 and shall continue until December 31, 2021. Termination of this relationship will be initiated and granted with a 60-day written notice by either party named in this agreement.
